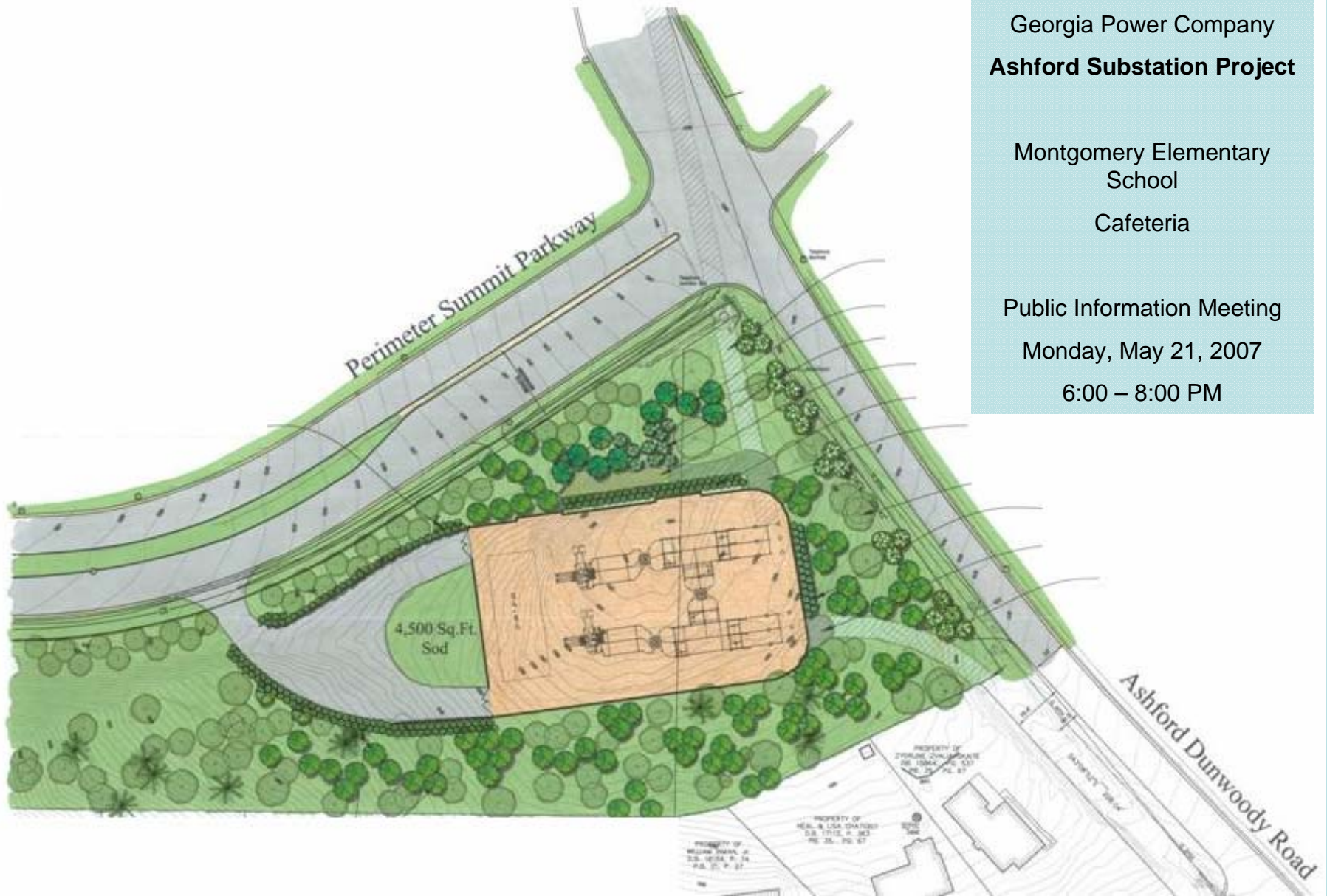

## Ashford Substation Project Key Points

- Load growth in the Ashford-Dunwoody area has led Georgia Power to build a new substation in order to maintain reliability and serve the growing area.
- Georgia Power looked at more than 20 sites and purchased a one acre site in 2005 to build a substation that will serve the general area south of I-285 along Ashford-Dunwoody Road and Perimeter Summit Parkway
- Georgia Power recently purchased three additional acres from Hines Development in 2007. This will allow Georgia Power numerous options and benefits to screen and reduce the visual impact of the facilities as well as construct the transmission and distribution lines underground.
- Georgia Power has been working with community leadership since November 2005 to develop a comprehensive landscape/screening plan. At the community's request, Georgia Power is using Roy Ashley & Associates, a local landscape consulting firm.
- Georgia Power purchased three houses along Dunwoody Lane that are adjacent to the substation site. The company's intent is to finish construction of the substation and then sell the three houses.
- Following the Open House on May 21st, Georgia Power will begin construction on the substation facility to meet the August 1, 2008 need date.
