The Ashford Alliance Community Association, a non-profit civic organization whose territory is roughly bordered by the Brookhaven, Chamblee and Dunwoody communities, consists of more than 65 individual neighborhoods and over 22,000 households. We are responding to an appeal from one of our sister organizations (the Brookhaven Peachtree Community Alliance) to support their position regarding the construction of a parking deck at the Brookhaven Marta station.

The Ashford Alliance Transportation Committee has reviewed and approved the proposal for MARTA to develop this deck in accordance with the specific provisions outlined by the Brookhaven LCI and agreed to by the BPCA. The Committee has recommended to our Board of Directors that the Alliance fully support this plan.

Brookhaven citizens and the BPCA worked very hard to develop the LCI guidelines for the area surrounding the MARTA station, and we know they deserve the best that can be delivered within these parameters. The Ashford Alliance especially applauds MARTA for the efforts made to include the several community-enhancing features (open space, community meeting area, etc.) in accordance with the Brookhaven Peachtree Overlay.

The Ashford Alliance Board of Directors supports MARTA in its grant application for the construction of a parking deck at Brookhaven under the provisions outlined above.
