



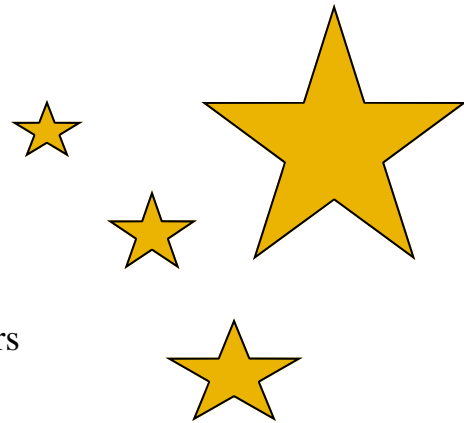
The **V**olunteers **I**n **P**atrol (VIP) program is a non-confrontational neighborhood patrol program that the DeKalb County Police Department is kicking off as part of the Department's Interactive Community Policing strategy.

**THE NEW PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO:**

- ★ Deter crime
- ★ Improve the quality of life
- ★ Provide a safer environment for neighborhoods
- ★ Impact crime by having citizens patrol their own neighborhoods
- ★ Allow volunteers to report suspicious or criminal activity to Interactive Community Policing Officers (ICP) or 911 (if an emergency)

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- ★ At least 21 years old
- ★ Must be a DeKalb County Resident
- ★ Complete a successful background check
- ★ Possess a valid Georgia Driver's License
- ★ Have had no moving violations in the last two (2) years
- ★ No prior Felony convictions
- ★ No Misdemeanor A or B convictions in the last five (5) years
- ★ No DUI convictions in last 10 years
- ★ Successfully complete all required training
- ★ Proof of Auto Insurance
